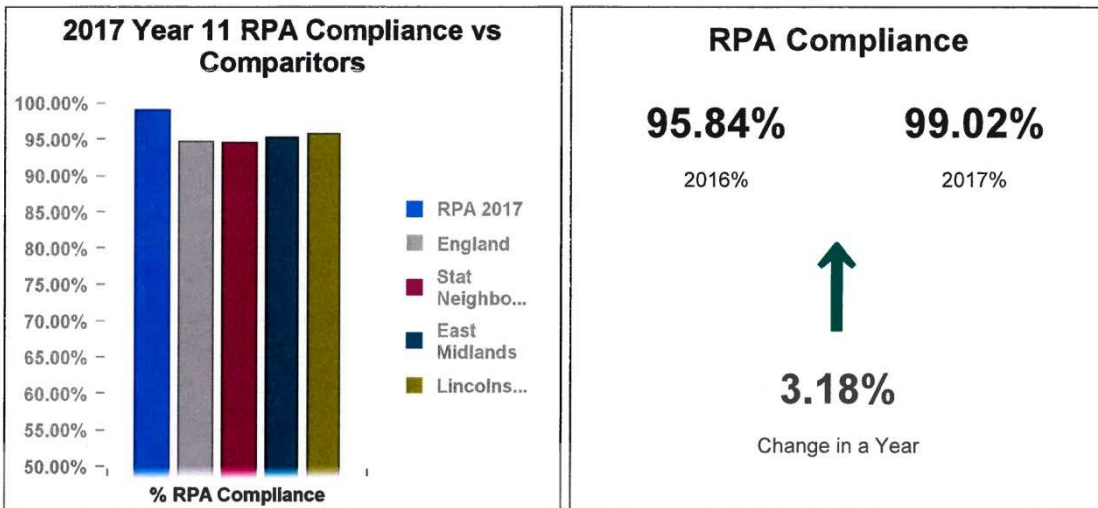

The June 2017 leavers fall under the Raising the Participation Age legislation, requiring all leavers to stay in learning until the end of the 2017/18 academic year. 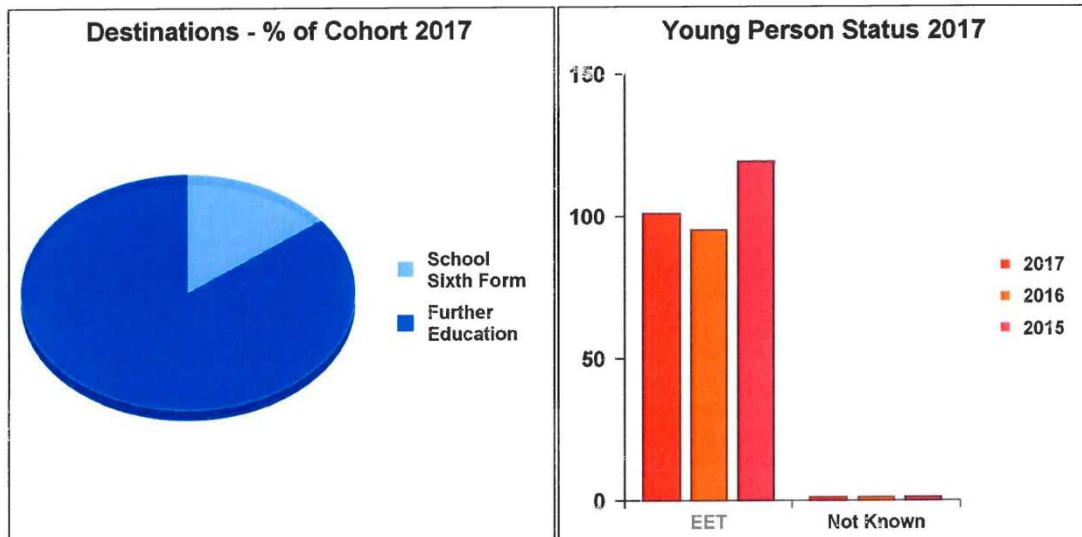

September Guarantee	The September Guarantee is based on those young people who are attending a Lincolnshire school as at the 30th of June each year. Each young person is entitled to a offer of education or training for the following academic year.
Employment with Training	Employees in a job that provides training or is combined with part time study that leads to a regulated qualification
Employment without training	Employees in a job that does not provide any training leading to qualifications
Not Known	A young person with a situation not currently known by the local authority.
